## 7 Lakota Values

## Questions

- 1. (Count on fingers) "Honesty, Humility, Generosity, Prayer, Respect, Wisdom and Compassion are the seven Lakota values.
  - a. **RIGHT**: The seven Lakota values are Honesty, Humility, Generosity, Prayer, Respect, Wisdom, and Compassion. **PROMPT**: What is a Lakota Value that you practice?
- 2. Respecting others means treating them the way you want to be treated.
  - a. **RIGHT**: Giving respect to everyone, especially elders, as they carry the knowledge of our Lakota culture and values.
- 3. Generosity means helping others and then wanting something in return.
  - a. WRONG: Generosity means helping others and NOT expecting anything in return. PROMPT: What are some ways you can help each other and be generous?
- 4. Our elders have wisdom
  - a. **RIGHT**: Our elders share their wisdom with us, as they have learned things their whole life. **PROMPT**: What is something wise your grandparents have told you?
- 5. Compassion is one of Lakota values that does not have much importance.
  - a. **WRONG**: Compassion is important to the Lakota people, as we all work together.
- 6. The Lakota people pray with the tobacco plant to give offerings to Unci Makha (mother earth)
  - a. **WRONG**: Our Lakota Oyate offered dried bark, known as Cansasa (red willow bark). **PROMPT**: What are somethings that you pray for?
- 7. Humility means that you don't brag, and treat everyone equal
  - a. **RIGHT**: It is important to have humility as we don't always know what others are going through. We are all equally important.
- 8. Being truthful means that you lie to others
  - a. **WRONG**: As Lakota people we believe in being honest, and telling truthful knowledge **PROMPT**: Why is it important that we tell the truth?
